Are there any books, authors, or magazines your child is a fan of? Pick them up at the library, or ask your librarian for suggestions.

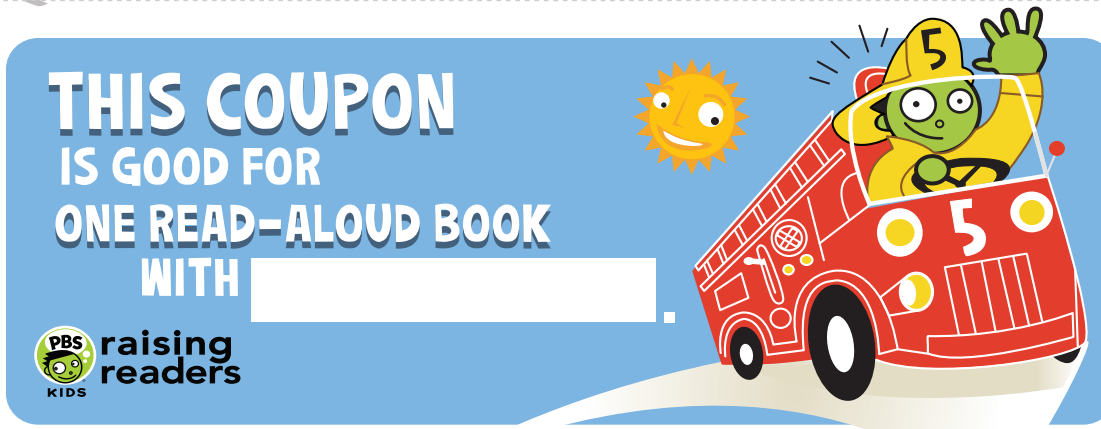
